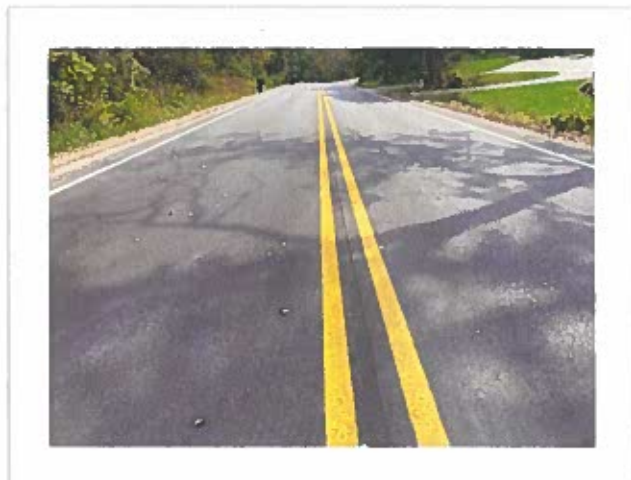

# PROPOSED COUNTYWIDE ROAD MILLAGE RENEWAL 2025-2034



The Road Commission is exploring a renewal of the ½ mil per year for ten years (2025 – 2034) for the purposes of continuing a fund for the reconstruction, resurfacing, and preventative maintenance of roads in Ottawa County.

Some of the criteria that will be considered to **annually** prioritize and select countywide road millage projects include:

- pavement conditions
- accident history
- input from local governmental officials and the public
- traffic volumes
- maintenance issues
- capacity and congestion issues
- other funding sources

- The potential project list is a non-inclusive pool of projects. Actual projects will be selected utilizing the annual Strategic Improvement Plan process and available funding resources.
- Estimated costs were based on projected inflation for 2025.
